### Installation

1. Make sure the Kratos switch is turned off before proceeding. Connect the battery pack plugs into the Kratos's 6" female plug.
2. Connect the 12" Universal Male Rx Plug to your R/C receiver battery slot.
3. Securely mount the Kratos switch to your R/C vehicle where it can be easily accessed. For panel mount applications, a 19.2 mm(0.756") x 12.9 mm(0.508") cutout is required for the Kratos to be slotted in. Panel thickness range of 1.27mm(0.050") to 3.8mm(0.150").
4. Now the Kratos can switch on your R/C power supply with the mounted switch.
5. Battery Pack Charging Plug:  
The 6" male charge plug is for charging the battery pack when the rocker switch is in the off position.
